Alcohol Service Guidelines

The Washington State Law requires that you purchase a banquet permit at: http://liq.wa.gov/licensing/banquet-permits in order to serve alcohol of any nature in a public assembly place. By signing the permit, you are assuming responsibility for the function, and guaranteeing that alcohol service will abide by state liquor laws (no person under 21 may consume alcohol, nor may any person apparently intoxicated be served). The banquet permit does not authorize the resale of the alcohol. Money cannot be exchanged in any manner when providing the guests with alcohol.

The following points will assist you in planning alcohol service.

- You are required to have a bartender present at the bar for the duration of alcohol service. The bartender MUST be hired through the caterer.
- ➤ The bar will be closed one hour prior to your contracted exit time (i.e. 8-4pm usage time, bar closes at 3pm). You may even wrap things up earlier if you choose. Last call will be ½ hour before closing the bar.
- ➤ Be sure to provide enough non-alcoholic beverages for those who will not be drinking alcohol, and for those who should no longer continue drinking.
- Always have enough designated drivers and remember that cabs are readily available.
- > Typically you will get 5-6 glasses from a bottle of wine and approximately 6-7 glasses from a bottle of champagne. There are 12 bottles per case.
- ➤ There are approximately 150 12 ounce (or 210 10 ounce) glasses of beer in a keg. And 24 beers to a case.
- ➤ Beer and wine that is left over is yours to take home. Should you run low during your event, additional beer and wine is available and the total will be deducted from your deposit.
